NEIGHBORHOOD NEWS UPDATE

MAY 1991

The ANNUAL MEETING of the Bryker Woods Neighborhood Association is scheduled to be held Thursday, May 16 at 7:00 pm in Bryker Woods Elementary School. Please mark your calendars and plan to attend. This year, the two run-off candidates for Austin City Council Place 2, Ginny Ballard and Ronney Reynolds, have agreed to address our annual meeting. Election of 1991 officers, a brief update of several neighborhood issues, a financial report, membership overview, and refreshments will all be a part of the meeting. Please remember, ALL residents of Bryker Woods are welcome ! Likewise, we are attempting to arrange for child care in the school library for kids not quite as interested in city elections . . .

Activities for the neighborhood association this spring have focused on discussions concerning the pending sale of the old "Flower Bucket" at 1604 West 34th Street. The association has worked closely with a photography portrait studio, About Faces, which is anticipating a move from Lamar Village to the property. Specifically, the neighborhood association was concerned with a possible zoning change request to retail zoning on the property.

Fortunately, an arrangement has been agreed upon for BWNA to assist the prospective new owner in his attempts to have portrait studios reclassified into the current zoning (LO) on the property. Nearly all other Texas cities currently include photographic portrait studios in lower volume, less intense zoning categories than Austin presently does. Thus, the solution arrived upon will hopefully best satisfy the needs and concerns of all involved.

As a reminder, all BWNA executive committee meetings are open to any BWNA member wishing to attend. Executive committee meetings are held throughout the year when a need or issue warrants, and residents may contact board members listed below to find out when and where the next meeting is scheduled.
